# From my Heart to your Heart



I am continuing being grateful for and spotlighting the members of the University Place Christian Church family, in reverse alphabetical order. Below is an introduction to my brother-in-law **Jeff Tunstall**, another new member to our congregation.

Jeffery Tunstall on February 10, 1957, was born in Bay Minette, Alabama, to his now deceased parents Charlie and Ruby Tunstall. Jeffery is the 12th child of 17 siblings all born to the same parents. Jeffery attended segregated elementary public school then middle school was integrated. He received his high school diploma from Continental Academy through a home school program.

In Jeffery's late teenage years, he received the Lord in his life at Pentecostal Temple of Memphis, Tennessee, where he later became a Sunday School teacher under the mentor of Sister Hattie Foots, where the late Bishop James Patterson was the Pastor.

Jeffery has been married to his wonderful wife, Lois Tunstall since 1987. They have four children, grown young men and seven grandchildren. Jeffery has long considered his family to be his most important ministry.

Jeffery is an ordained minister where he and his wife have shared in ministry at Las Vegas, Nevada; Denver, Colorado; Bay Minette, Alabama; and back to Las Vegas, Nevada.

Jeffery received a commercial driver's license from the University of Arkansas, and worked in the transportation field for many years. He later received a State of Nevada Private Investigators License where he worked as a security officer for Special Operational Security in Las Vegas, Nevada.

Jeffery and Lois moved to Enid in November of 2022 to help Pastor Vera Porter with the ministry at University Place. After the move, Jeffery was admitted to the hospital where he was diagnosed with a cancerous tumor next to his liver.
